# Statistics for Private Schools in Dubai 2010/2011 

## Introduction

Accurate information on private schools and numbers of students at private schools is essential for policymakers and educators to understand trends and to ensure sufficient capacity exists into the future. This publication outlines the key statistics for the 2010/11 academic year for private schools in Dubai.

## Students and Schools

Enrolments of students in schools are continuing to expand in Dubai, with a $5.7 \%$ increase in the number of Dubai school students compared to the previous year. Numbers of students in Dubai's public schools have increased over the past two academic years, reversing the prior historical trend. In 2010/11, $87.7 \%$ of the students in Dubai were enrolled in one of the private schools.

There are 13 different types of curriculum on offer in Dubai's private schools. Most of the students attend UK curriculum schools (31\%), Indian curriculum schools (30\%) or US curriculum schools (21\%). Student numbers have increased across all the main curricula from the previous academic year apart from Private MoE curriculum schools.

There are around 29,000 UAE national children attending private schools. This is $56.7 \%$ of all UAE National student enrolments. This proportion has stablised at about this level for the past three academic years. The number of expatriate children has increased by $6 \%$ since last year. More children in Dubai private schools are in the junior grades compared with senior grades.

More than half (52\%) of the teachers are working in Kindergartens and Cycle 1 (Grade 1-5) schools. There are very few national teachers in private schools. 79.5\% of the teachers in Dubai's private schools are female.
