

Summary of Inspection Findings 2021-2022



Renaissance School opened in 2018. It caters to boys and girls from Pre-K to Grade 6 offering a U.S. curriculum, aligned to New York State Standards. The school is in Sports City, Dubai. At the time of inspection, it had 557 students on roll. The March 2022 inspection was the first since the school opened.



Ms. Salma Sidqi Eid joined in 2019 and she is the school's second principal. Still a growing school, 25% of teachers changed between the previous and current academic years.



The school is acceptable meaning that it does not yet fully meet all of the standards expected by the UAE. The principal and other leaders manage the school satisfactorily. The curriculum is well planned and effectively delivered. Most leaders have a good understanding of what strong teaching and learning looks like.



Kindergarten and elementary students generally make good progress in subjects other than Arabic. The progress of middle school students is only acceptable in many subjects. Although class teachers and learning assistants endeavour to support students of determination, there are not enough specialist teachers to support them adequately. Students and teachers use technology to make learning interesting. They take part in competitions and other activities. Students mostly behave well, work well together, and enjoy their learning. They understand and appreciate Emirati culture and the Islamic values underpinning UAE society.



The school provides a secure and hygienic premises and offers a good standard of care. Parents feel welcome and are an important part of the educational community. Students say they are happy and proud to belong to Renaissance School.

The next steps for the school are to ensure:



- leaders have sufficient time and adequate training to enable them to perform their duties successfully;
- the self-evaluation processes are more accurate;
- assessment results are used to adapt the curriculum and modify teaching to meet the needs of all students, including students of determination and
- support for students of determination is sufficient to enable them to make rapid progress.
