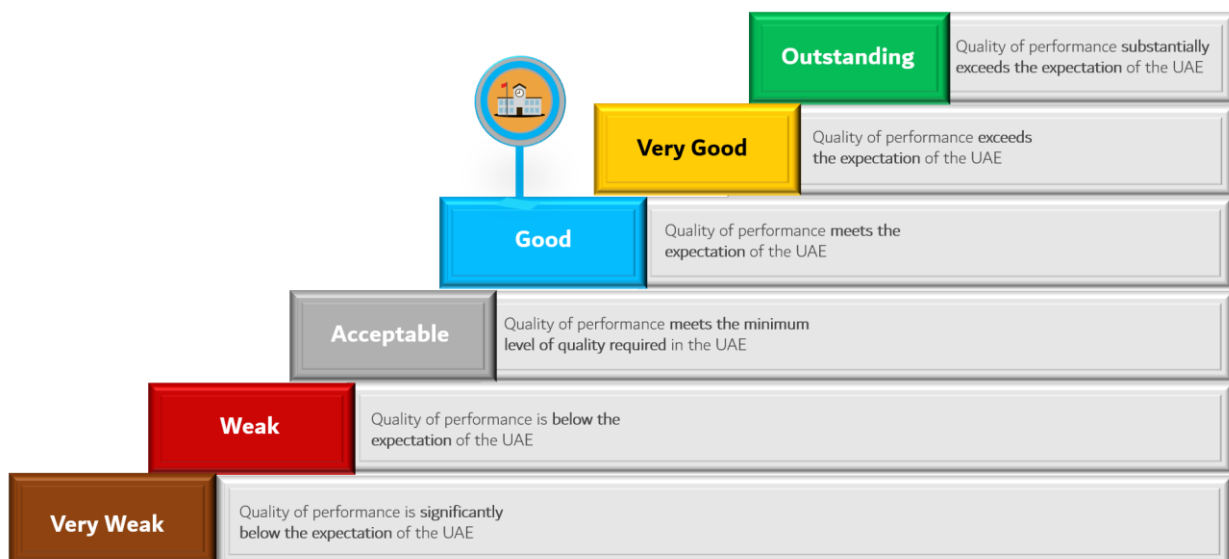

Summary of Inspection Findings 2021-2022



Ambassador International Academy opened in 2019. It presently offers education in the context of the International Baccalaureate (IB) to boys and girls from Pre-KG to Grade 8. The school is located in Al Quoz 2. At the time of its first inspection, in March 2022, there were 1033 students in the school.



The principal Mr James Lynch, joined the school in 2019, as its first leader. The number of teachers has increased to 91 in line with the increase of student numbers. A third of teachers are new to the school this year.



The school provides a 'good' overall quality of education to its students, meeting the expectations of the UAE. All leaders have a shared understanding of the curriculum, teaching and how students learn best.



Across the school students make good progress in English, mathematics and science across all phases. Their progress is only acceptable in Islamic Education and Arabic. In this inclusive school, students of determination make good progress. The use of technology across all phases supports and enhances learning.



The school's arrangements for the care, health, safety and security of students and staff is very good. Parents are respected and actively involved in their children's education.



The next steps for the school are to ensure that:

- achievement in Islamic Education and Arabic is increased,
- student awareness of Islamic values and the culture and heritage of the UAE improves, and
- there are further developments in students' innovation and enterprise skills.
