

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

Summary of Inspection Findings 2021-2022



Ignite School opened in 2018. The school is in Al Warqa'a 3, Dubai. The inspection in February 2022 was the first since the school opened. It intends to offer an American curriculum to boys and girls from KG to Grade 12. At the time of inspection, it had 686 students from KG to Grade 8.



Ms. Wedad Saada joined the school in 2021. She is the third principal appointed since the school opened. Around 39% of teachers changed between the 2020-2021 and the 2021-2022 academic years.



The school provides an acceptable quality of education to its students. This means that it meets the minimum level of quality required in the UAE. The principal and senior leaders work to ensure students are safe and enjoy learning. Most leaders in the school understand how children learn, and how teachers can teach best.



Students make acceptable progress in almost all subjects. An exception is in Arabic as an additional language in the middle school. Students of determination receive appropriate support and make acceptable progress. Most teachers use technology to make learning interesting to their students. Students take part in a variety of school activities and do well in sports and innovation events.



The school offers high standards of care, and the premises are secure and hygienic. Parents feel welcome at the school and are an important part of school life. Students behave well and treat each other with respect throughout the school. Their attendance is only acceptable. They volunteer in activities to improve the school environment and beyond.

The next steps for the school are to ensure that:



- teaching is more effective in all phases
- there are more opportunities for students to collaborate and investigate
- students make better progress in all subjects, especially in Arabic as an additional language
- the self-evaluation process is more realistic and leads to better targeted plans for improvement.
