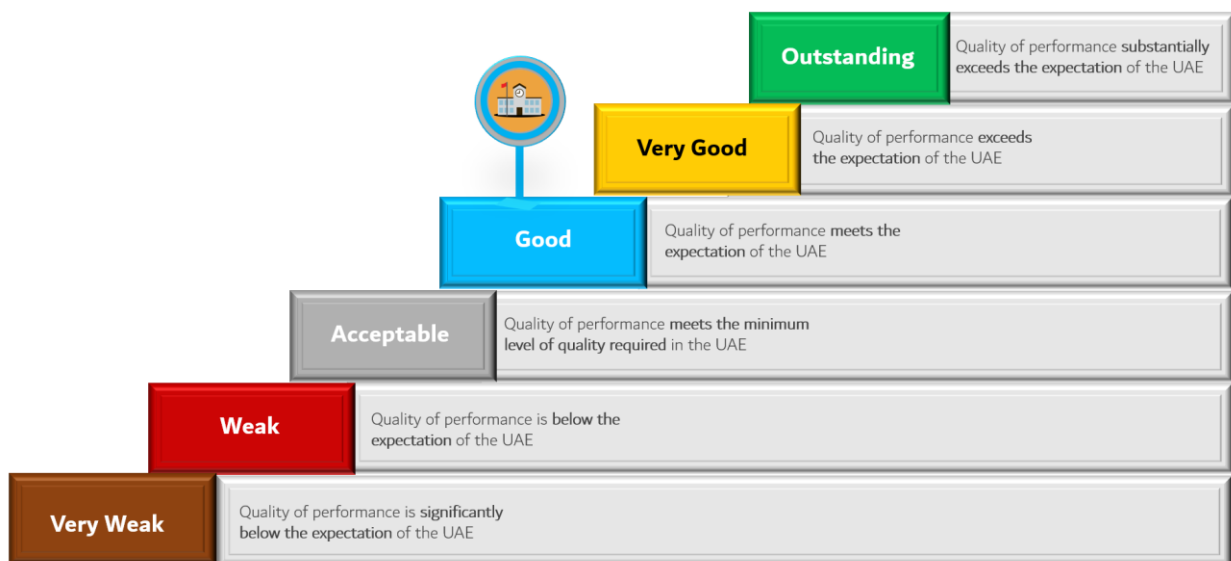

Summary of Inspection Findings 2021-2022



South View School opened in 2018. It offers the National Curriculum for England (NCfE) to boys and girls from the Foundation Stage to Year 13. It is located in Dubai Land. At the time of inspection, it had 1052 students from FS1 to Year 10. The first inspection of the school was in March 2022.



Mr. Reuben David Flint joined the school in 2021 and is the second principal appointed since the school opened. New teaching staff are added as the school increases its student population and year groups.



The school provides a 'Good' quality of education to its students. This means that it meets the expectations of the UAE. The principal and leadership team have developed in a short space of time, a vibrant school community, based on a vision of inclusion and diversity. Most leaders in the school have a very good understanding of how children learn and how teachers can teach best.



Students are making good progress in almost all subjects except in Islamic Education and Arabic. Students of determination are well supported and make good progress. Students and teachers use technology well to make learning interesting. A variety of after-school activities are available for students to enjoy and be involved.



The school offers a very safe, caring and secure environment. Parents feel welcome at the school and are an important part of the educational community. Students report that they are happy at the school and have positive attitudes towards learning. They enjoy taking on roles of responsibility within the school community.

The next steps for the school are to ensure that:



- attainment and progress in Islamic Education and Arabic improves
- the quality of teaching and use of assessment helps students to make even faster progress
- leaders support teachers even further with appropriate training which meets their needs.
